RECRUITMENT OF SCALE I OFFICERS

The Corporation has been receiving queries regarding the interpretation of the percentage of marks to be scored in Graduation/Post-graduation. The clarification to the same is as given below:

The percentage check to score atleast 60% marks for General & OBC candidates and atleast 55% marks for SC/ST candidates is on the degree qualification mentioned under the heading **Essential Qualification** for any stream.

If the degree mentioned under the heading Essential Qualification is Graduation then the General & OBC candidates should have scored atleast 60% marks (aggregate) in Graduation and SC/ST candidates should have scored atleast 55% marks (aggregate) in Graduation

And

If the degree mentioned under the heading Essential Qualification is Post-Graduation then the General & OBC candidates should have scored atleast 60% marks (aggregate) in Post-Graduation and SC/ST candidates should have scored atleast 55% marks (aggregate) in Post-Graduation.

In case of Specialist streams wherein the essential qualification required is CA/ICWA/CS/ CS Inter, the qualification requirements remain unchanged.
